In order to radically review the content of training in accordance with the priority tasks of the country's socio-economic development, to create the necessary conditions for the training of specialists with higher education at the level of international standards, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan adopted April 20, 2017 No. PP-2909 "On measures for further the development of higher education." This decision approved the Program for the comprehensive development of the higher education system for the period 2017 - 2021 for the qualitative and cardinal improvement of the level of higher education, strengthening and modernizing the material and technical base of higher educational institutions, equipping with modern educational and scientific laboratories, information and communication technologies.

Resolution determined strategy of development of higher education system and its objectives. PAWER and its outputs addresses to fulfillment of following objectives: the establishment by each higher educational institution close partnerships with leading specialized foreign scientific and educational institutions, the wide introduction of advanced pedagogical technologies, curricula and teaching materials based on international educational standards in the educational process, and active involvement of highly qualified teachers and scientists from foreign educational partner institutions, the organization in a systematic way internship of undergraduates, young teachers and scientific personnel, retraining and improvement of professional skill of teachers; the formation of the target parameters for the training of personnel with higher education, the optimization of areas and specialties of education in higher educational institutions according to development of regions and sectors of the economy, the needs of implemented regional and sectoral development programs;

the creation and wide introduction of a new generation of teaching materials in the higher education system, the provision of higher educational institutions with up-to-date learning, educational, methodological and scientific literature, including through the acquisition and

translation of the latest foreign literature, regular updating of funds of information centers and libraries:

continuous increase in the level and quality of professional skills of faculty, further training and internships for teachers and researchers, graduates abroad, the wide involvement in the educational process of higher educational institutions and centers for retraining and advanced training of highly qualified foreign scientists, teachers and specialists; strengthening the scientific potential of higher educational institutions, the further development of university science, strengthening its integration with academic science, increasing the efficiency and effectiveness of research activities of faculty members, involving advanced students in scientific activities;

equipping higher educational institutions with the means of modern information and communication technologies, expanding the access of students, teachers and young researchers to world educational resources, electronic catalogs of advanced scientific literature and databases.

According to decree of the President of Uzbekistan on additional measures to improve the quality of education in higher educational institutions and ensure their active participation in ongoing large-scale reforms in the country, dated June 5, 2018 No. PP-3775, the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan developed and approved the Regulation on the system for monitoring and evaluating the knowledge of students in higher educational institutions, with focus on bringing the system and evaluation criteria in line with the stages of the continuing education system according to best international experience and peculiarities of educational areas.
